

Senior competitors fees for 2011/12 season

For senior competitors this season we are introducing a compulsory competition fee of \$100. Life Saving Victoria carnivals are \$20 per carnival this year and there are 6 carnivals in total.

This does not include the State Titles or Masters Titles, competitors will be responsible for these entry fees.

We are trialling a new initiative this year as follows:

- a - The competition fee will be a rebate offer. If you attend 2 of our tin shakes with 2 x 4 hour shifts[#] and attend all of your rostered patrols* your competition fee will be paid back to you reimbursed at end of the season. Our tin shake money is a vital part of our fund-raising each season. It allows us to upgrade equipment for our nippers, our patrols and our senior competitors.
- b- Any competitor that attends the Australian Titles will have their entry fee paid by the club.
- c - If you are selected in a state or national representative team, the club will provide financial assistance to the order of \$200 per club member to a maximum of \$300 per financial year. This will be for flights & accommodation. This only applies if the carnivals are held interstate.

Your competition fee must be paid along with your membership fees which are due prior to the commencement of the season. You will not be allowed to requal, patrol or compete until these have been paid. There are no exceptions with this. We must reiterate that you are not insured unless you have paid your fees.

We are trialling this for the upcoming 2011/12 season. Once we have reviewed it at the end of the season, we would be hoping to implement this within the junior competitors next season[^].

[#]You must be 16 years and over to attend a tin shake. If you are under this age, a parent or guardian must take your place. This can be done in 2 x 4 hour shifts, 1 x 8 hour shift etc.

^{*}If you are unable to attend your rostered patrol, you must find suitable replacement who has an equivalent or higher qualification than yourself.

[^]Junior competitors who are selected in state teams are also eligible for the assistance offered in 'c' above.
