### **BOARD OF MANAGEMENT CODE OF CONDUCT**

This policy applies to those undertaking a Board of Management (BOM)/Committee role within the Club.

- All BOM/Committee must be financial members of the club and hold a current Working with Children Check.
- All BOM/Committee must disclose any conflict of interests prior to being elected to position.
- All BOM/Committee must act in the best interest of the club and not of individuals.

All BOM/Committee must adhere to Life Saving Victoria Behavioural Guidelines for children and young people

They need to provide a positive and nurturing experience for all and ensure that children and young people (and adults) are not exploited, abused or harmed during their involvement in activities.

All BOM/Committee may become aware of information about the club or its members that need to be kept to a confidential matter. This must be adhered to and breaching of this is not an option.
