COACHES/AGE MANAGERS CODE OF CONDUCT

This policy applies to those undertaking coaching roles either as a Club Coach or as an Age Manager within nippers age groups.

A Club Coach is someone who conducts a guided coaching activity on a regular basis to club members.

A Club Coach may also be someone who conducts school based water activities for school programs conducted by the club.

An Age Manager is someone who conducts nipper activities for a specified age group on a regular basis for the club.

- All Coaches/Age Managers must be financial members of the club and hold a current Working with Children Check.
- All coaches must hold the SLSA coaching accreditation/qualifications as outlined by the governing body
- All Coaches need to hold a current First Aid Certificate
- All Age Managers need to be aware of who the qualified First Aider is each week.
- All Coaches must adhere to the Code of Conduct at all times including but not limited to water safety assessments and conduct.

All Coaches/Age Managers must adhere to Life Saving Victoria Behavioural Guidelines for children and young people
