



## **MORDIALLOC LIFE SAVING CLUB**

### **PATROLLING POLICY**

- Financial members aged 15 and over currently holding a bronze medallion or SRC aged 13-14 will be expected to perform a minimum of 20 hours of patrol during a season and prior to competing at the next State Championships.  
\*All patrolling members are expected to attend their rostered patrols, but can also attend any others they would like to.
- Members not meeting the above criteria will not be eligible for end of season awards
- Members not meeting the above criteria will not be entered into State Championship events
- Patrolling members are to find a suitable replacement (someone with similar qualifications) in advance, if they are aware they are not able to attend a rostered patrol and inform the Patrol Captain for that day.
- If patrolling members miss allocated patrol without a replacement or valid excuse (spoken or let their patrol captain know) then may not be able to compete at the next carnival. If this occurs on several occasions then they may not be able to compete at States or Aussies.
- All patrol members will work as a team to make sure the beach is patrolled at all times and that they are following all instructions asked (within reason) from their patrol captain.
- If there is an issue with their current patrol captain or an issues during patrol, then the patrolling member is encouraged to speak to the club captain or director of Life Saving Operations for further direction.
- It is encouraged that bronze holders attain other award(s) such as Advance Resuscitation Techniques (ART) Inflatable rescue Boat Crew and or Driver (IRBD or IRBC) Their Basic Beach Management (BBM) Senior First Aid (Level 2)
